- To provide inputs to international processes

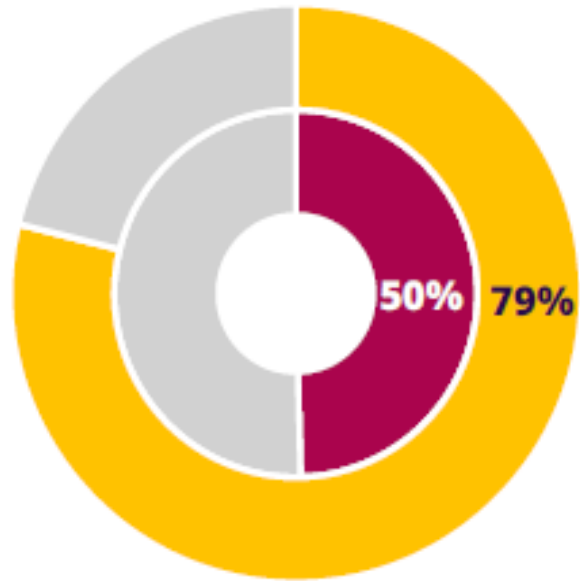

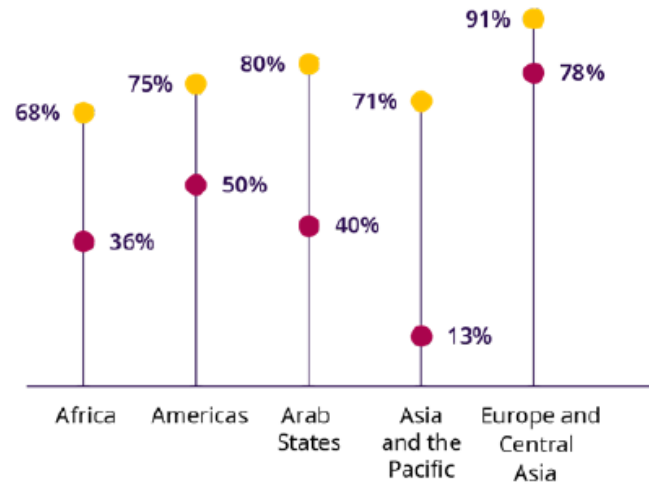
Approach

- Coverage: NDCs 2.0 and NDCs 3.0 (submissions up to 30 November 2025)
- Focus on textual references and high-level analysis
- Complements qualitative case studies

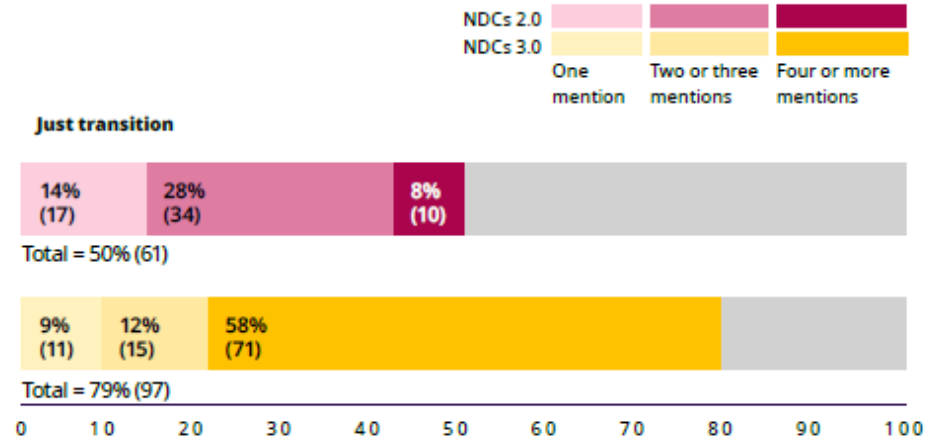

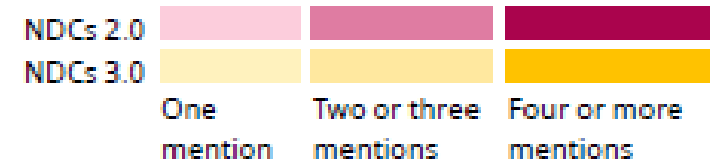


NDCs grouped by no. of references

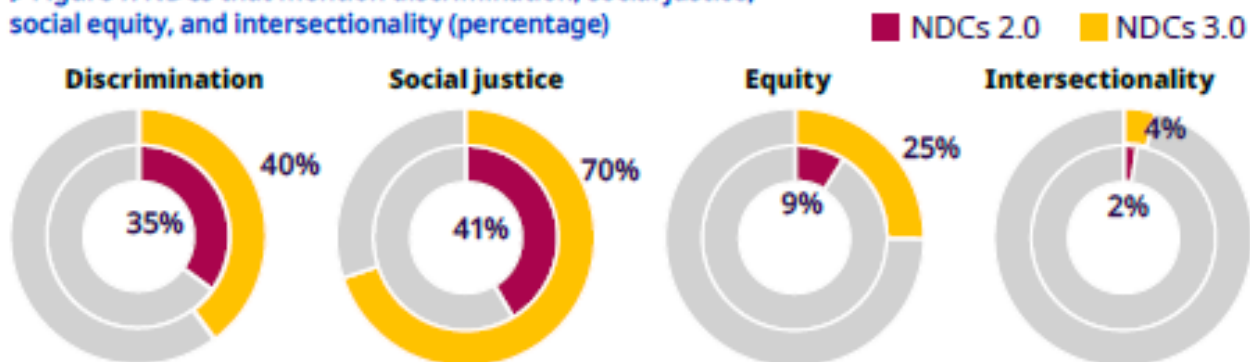

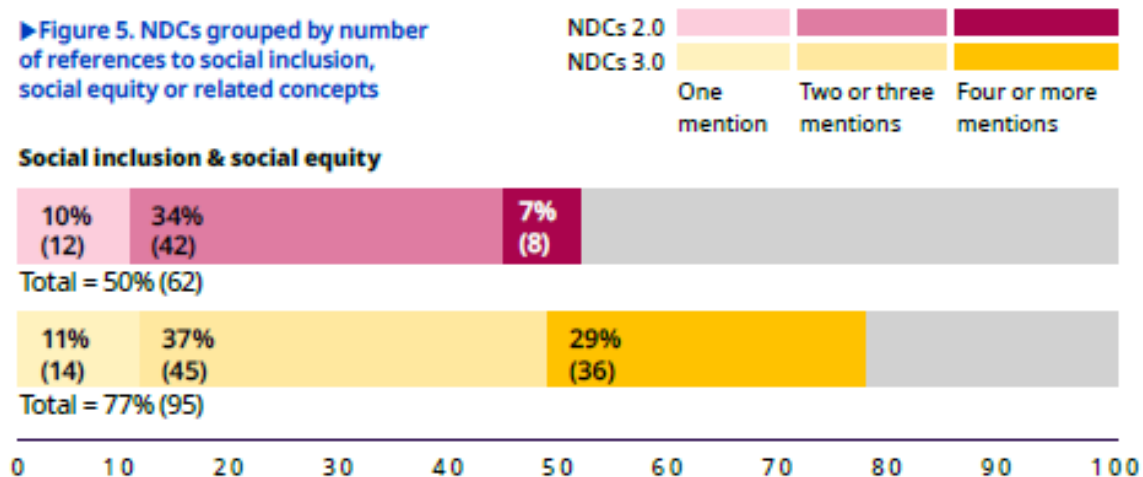

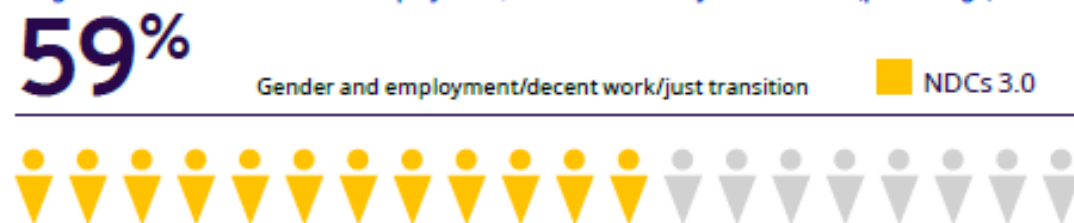
► Figure 7. NDCs that mention discrimination, social justice, social equity, and intersectionality (percentage)



► Figure 5. NDCs grouped by number of references to social inclusion, social equity or related concepts



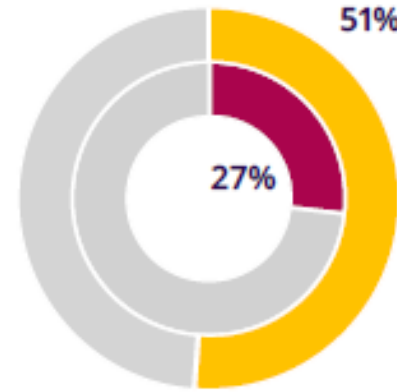
► Figure 8. Gender in relation to employment, decent work and just transition (percentage)



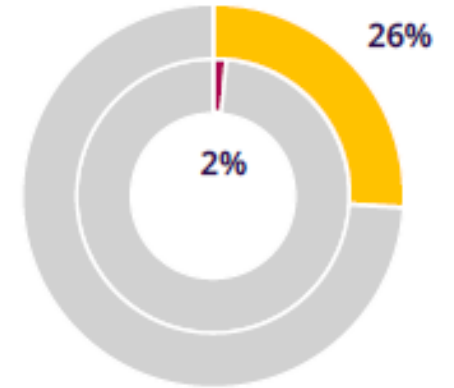

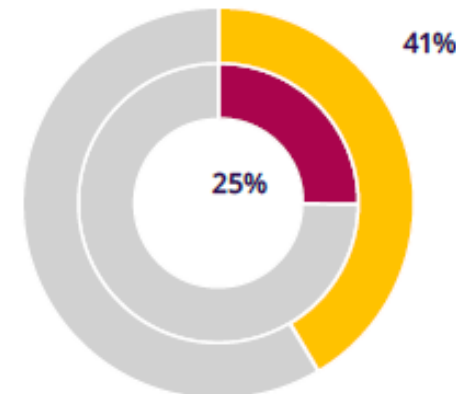

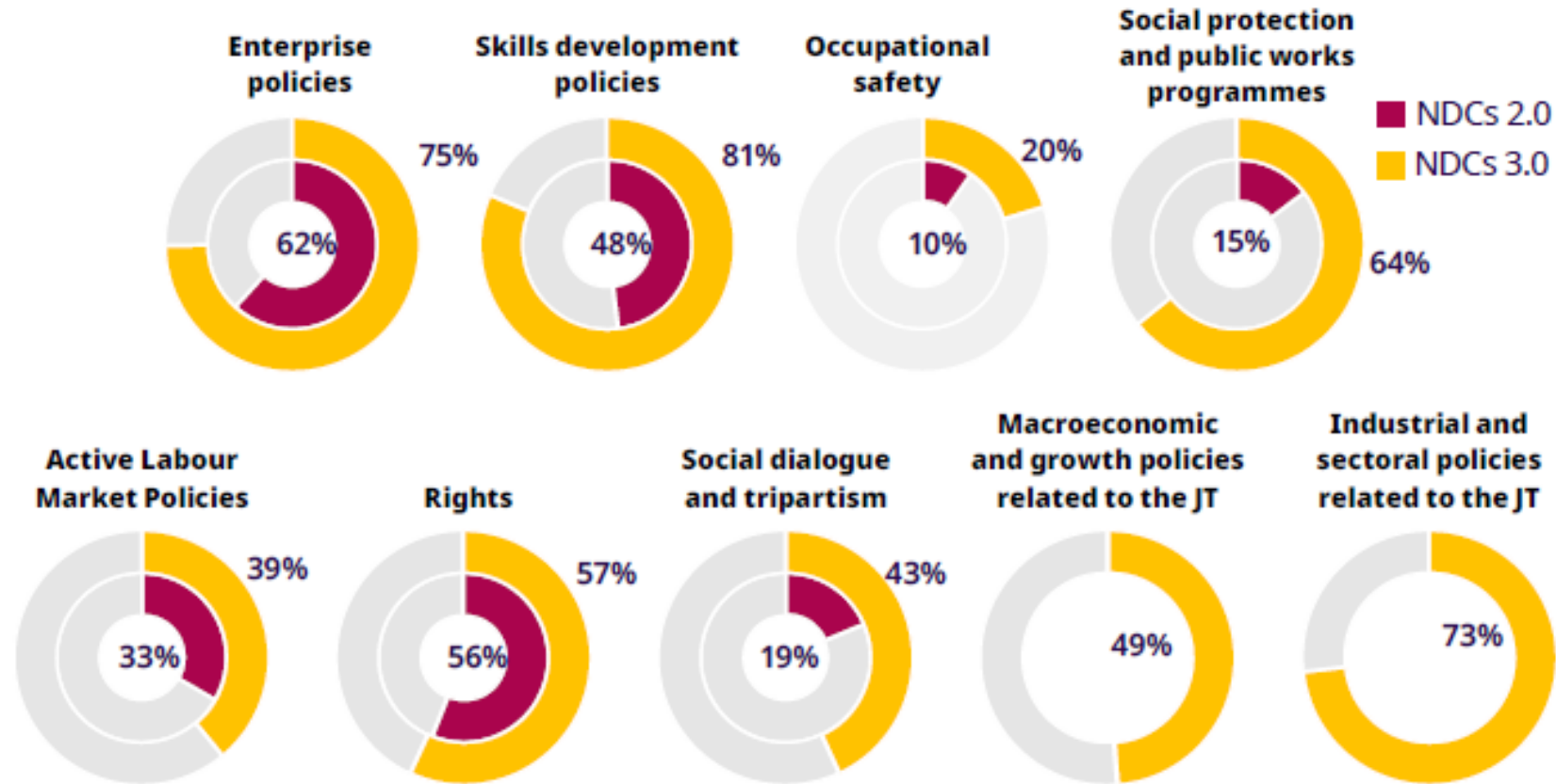

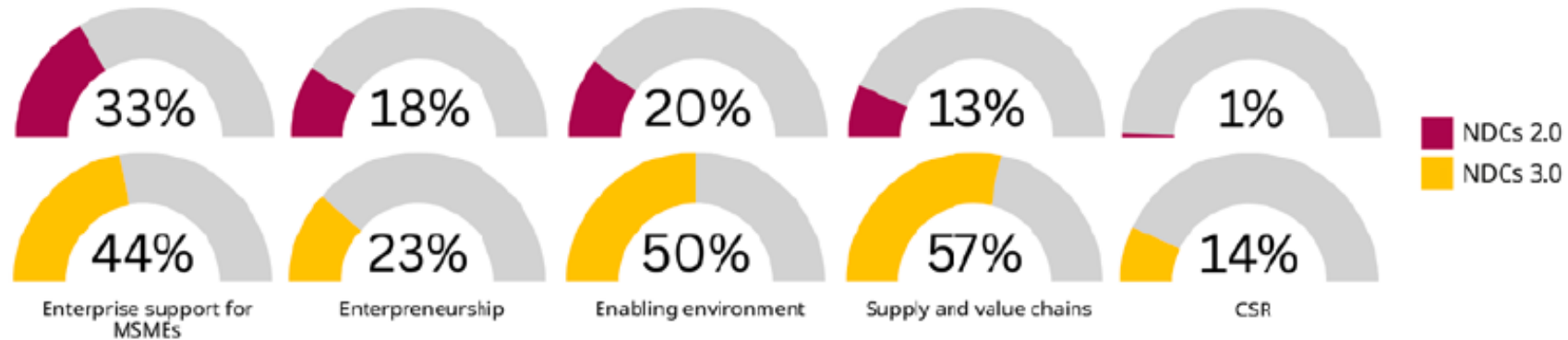

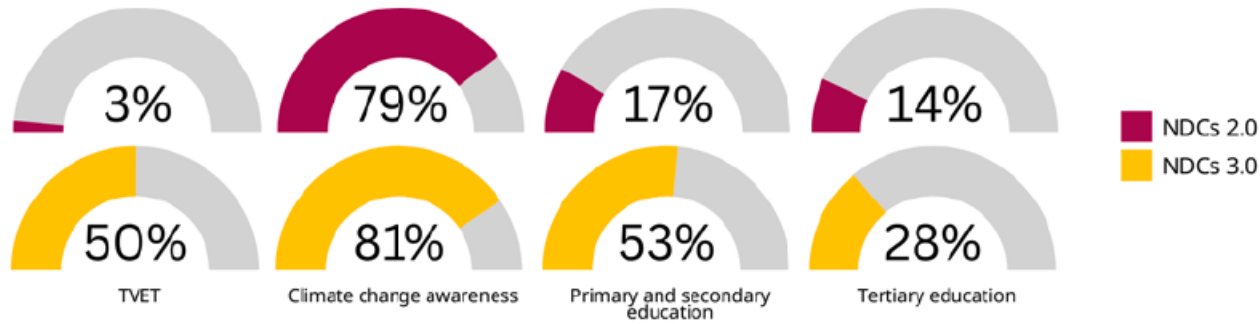

Types of policy elements mentioned (percentage)

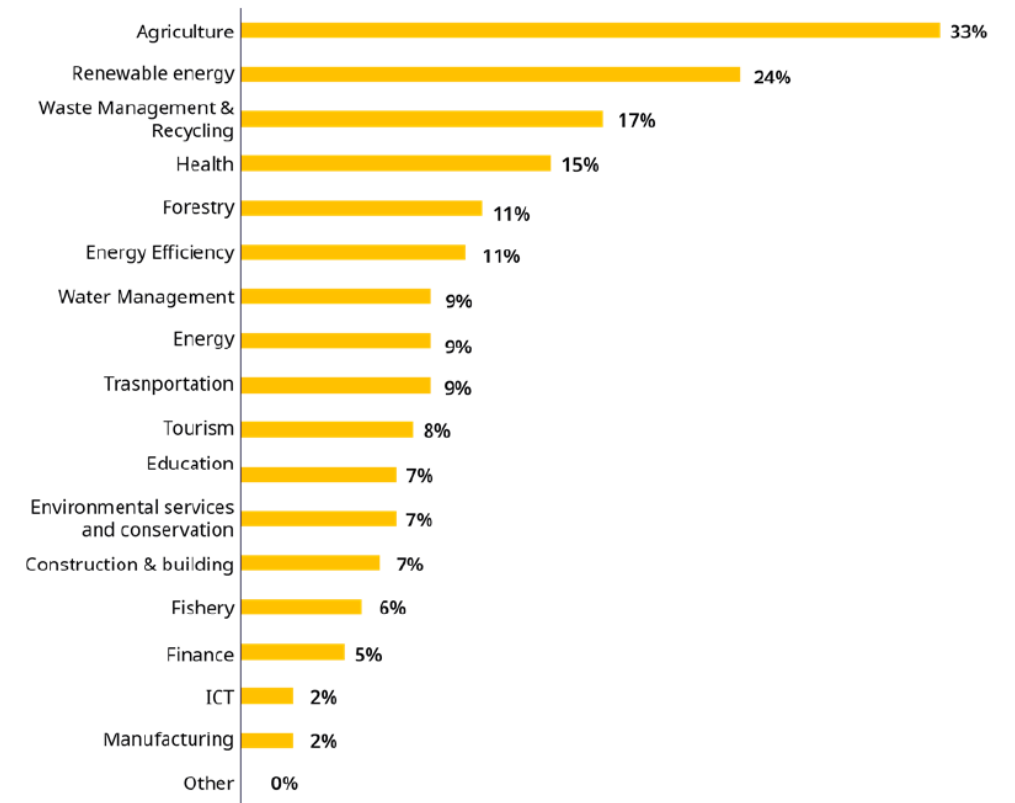


Skill development policies

Types of education and training programmes mentioned (percentage)

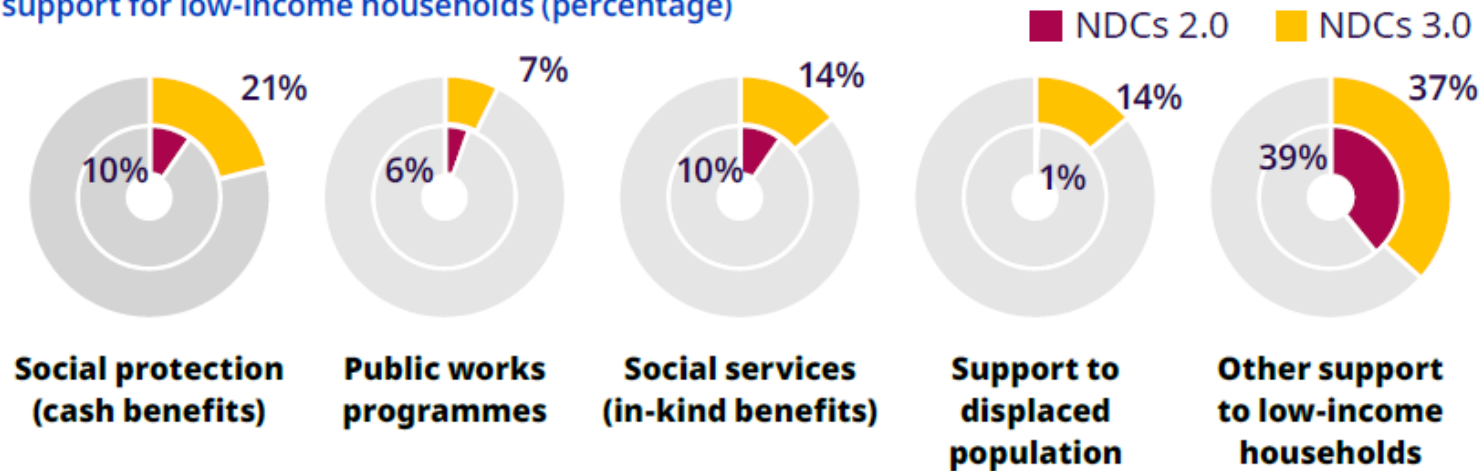


Targeted sectors by skills development policy measures (percentage)



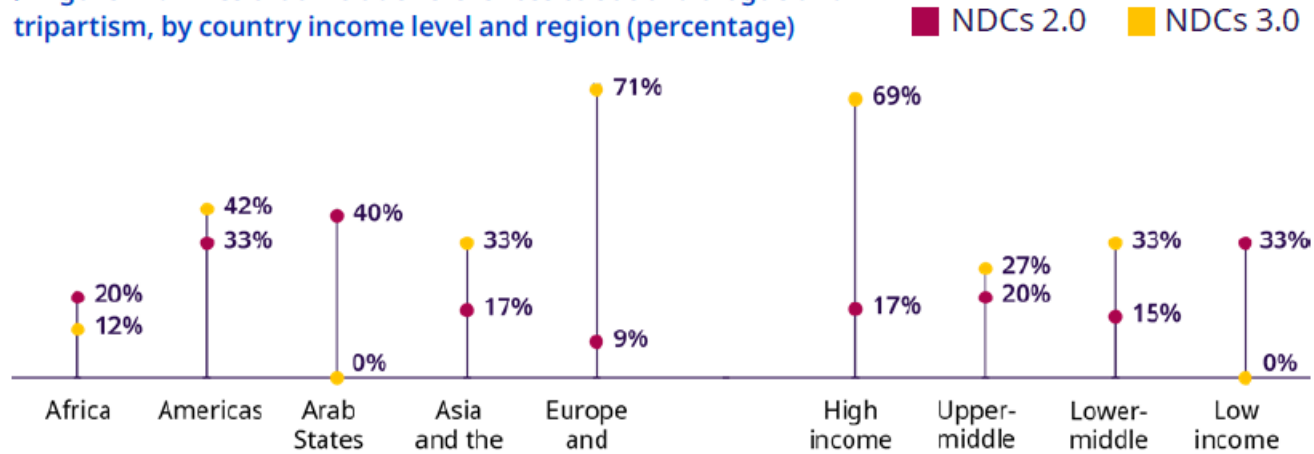
Social protection and other interventions to support low-income households

NDCs that mention social protection and other support for low-income households (percentage)

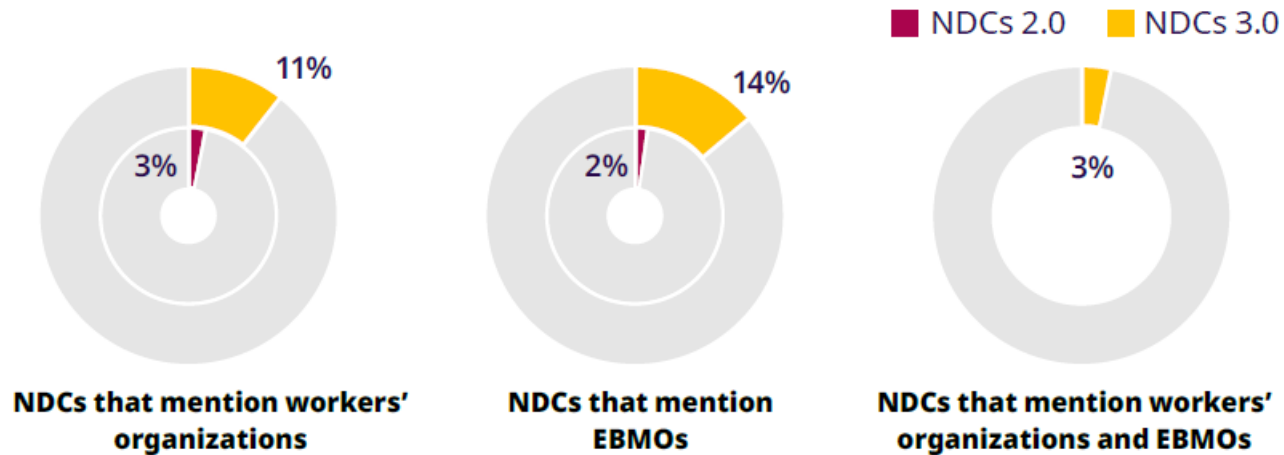

► Figure 22. NDCs that include references to social dialogue and tripartism, by country income level and region (percentage)

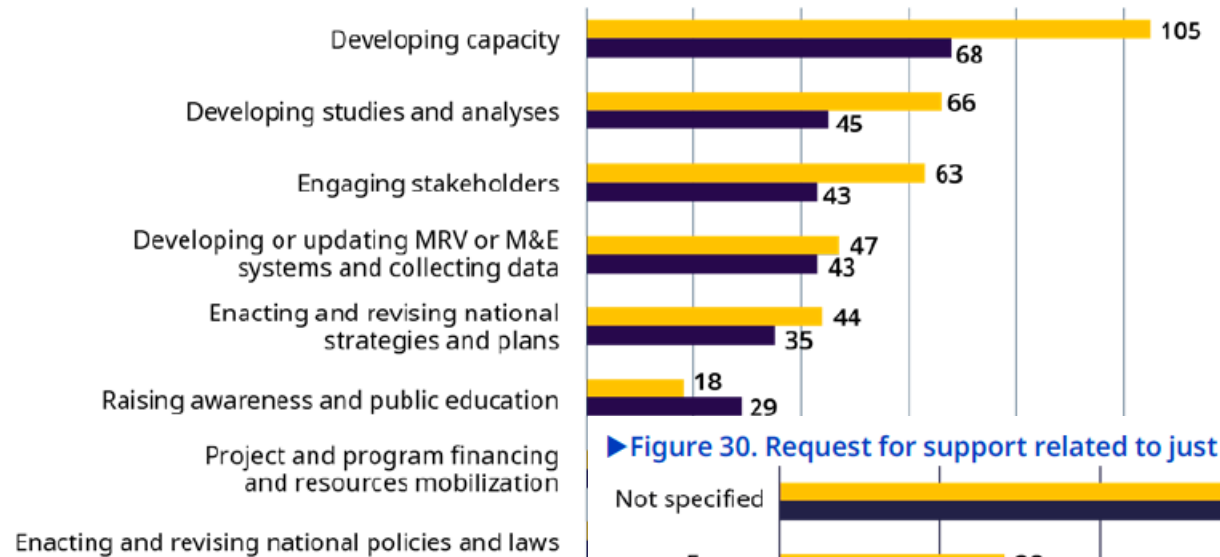


► Figure 23. Reference to workers' organizations and EBMOs in the NDCs (percentage)

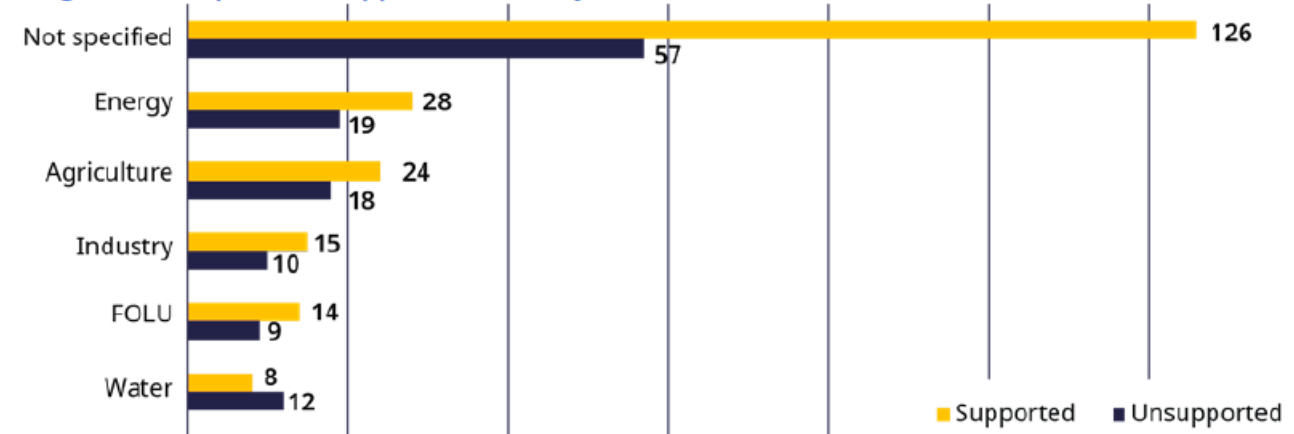
